## What will happen?

If a child is isolating due to Covid, we will provide work which closely matches the work in the classroom.

- In KS1/KS2 we use Class Dojo as our platform and in EYFS we use Tapestry
- Work will include:

Daily	Weekly
Phonics (EYFS & KS1) Reading Writing Maths	Science Computing RE History or Geography Art of DT Music PE MFL – French (KS2)

## What if I can't access online learning?

For families who cannot access online learning, we can either loan you a device from school or print the work that has been set.

## Who will contact me?

Where an individual is isolating, a member of SLT will contact you on day 2 or 3 of isolation to ensure that your child has been able to access remote learning online. This will be followed up with a call later in the isolation period to monitor and support how the child is accessing their learning.

Where a class or bubble has closed, class teachers will monitor the children's engagement with online learning. More detail on this is provided on the remote learning section of the website. Where children are identified as vulnerable, either through a SEND need or safeguarding, they will receive regular calls from a member of the senior leadership team whilst Remote Learning is in place.

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
