Our Learning in PSHE 2022 -2023

PSHE Curriculum Intent:

Children's holistic development is covered at Wembdon through the delivery of RSHE which is a vital part of the curriculum.

The subject contents aim is to provide children with the knowledge, skills and understanding that they will need to become confident, healthy, independent individuals that will grow to become active and responsible members of society.

All children at Wembdon are encouraged to participate in a range of activities and experiences across and beyond the curriculum, including circle time and contributing fully to the life of their school and community. In doing so they will recognise their own worth, work well with others and become increasingly responsible for their own learning. They reflect on their experiences and understand how they are developing personally and socially, tackling many of the spiritual, moral, social, and cultural issues.

All children will have the opportunity to discuss and learn techniques to improve in eight areas of 'success'. These areas include: to try new things; to work hard; to concentrate; to push themselves; to imagine; to improve; to understand others and become to not give up.

At Wembdon St. George's school we follow a scheme of work called JIGSAW.

This incorporates a mindful approach to RSHE through the delivery of a comprehensive scheme of learning which also includes emotional literacy.

The Social and Emotional Aspects of Learning Programme is also incorporated within the JIGSAW scheme. This is used to teach social, emotional, and behavioural skills to all pupil alongside social skills and spiritual development.

The Jigsaw Program combines RSHE education, emotional literacy, social skills, and spiritual development in a comprehensive scheme of learning. The teaching strategies are differentiated to accommodate a variety of different learning styles. It is designed with a whole school approach in mind, with all year groups working on the same theme (Puzzle) at the same time.

Each of these half-termly Puzzles start with an introductory whole school assembly.

The JIGSAW Program

There are six Puzzles in Jigsaw that are designed to progress in sequence from September to July.

The Six Puzzles are as follow:

Autumn 1: Being Me in My World

Autumn 2: Celebrating Difference (including anti-bullying)

Spring 1: Dreams and Goals

Spring 2: Healthy Me

Summer 1: Relationships

Summer 2: Changing Me including RSE (Relationship and Sex Education)
